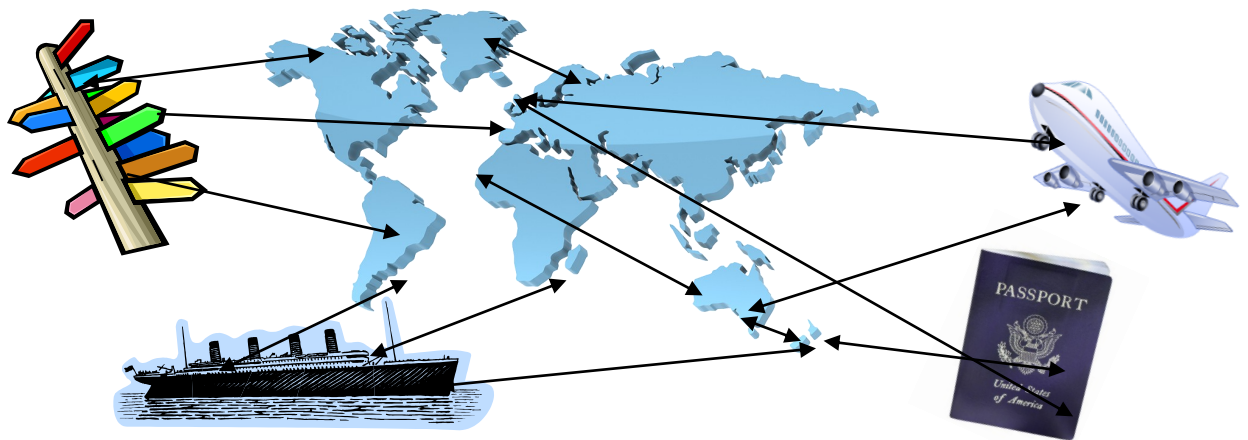

#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR EXHIBITORS

1. All works must be the original uncopied work of the artist and be suitably framed and ready for hanging with D rings and wire.
2. An identification label must be attached to the back of each entry.
3. The Gallery takes 25% commission on sales (20% for Friends of KCGI)
4. Entry fee for each work is \$6.00, or 5 works for \$24.00 ( \$3.00 each or 5 for \$12.00 for Friends of KCGI). The fee for school students is \$1.00 per entry.
  - 4a. In the event that too many exhibits are received the Gallery reserves the right to choose which works will be displayed and no refunds will be made for works not displayed.
  - 4b. In accordance with 4a exhibitors should list their entries numerically 1 to 5 on the Entry Form in order of their preference for work to be displayed.
5. Artists payments will be made within two weeks of the completion of the exhibition.
6. Art work not for sale will be listed as NFS.
7. The Gallery reserves the right to refuse exhibits without being required to give a reason.
8. Artists are responsible for delivery and collection of work to and from the Gallery within the times stated as per "Delivery & Collection" information.
9. Artists are advised to arrange to have their work insured for transit, storage, and while on display. While due care is taken, the gallery accepts no responsibility for loss or damage of artworks.
10. Artists may consult with the Gallery regarding installation/hanging of their work, but the Gallery reserves the right to make the final decision.
11. The Gallery arranges opening functions and may invite guest speakers.
12. The Gallery maintains a mailing list and designs it's own invitations and posters for openings. On request invitations will be made available to the artist for their own guests.
13. The Gallery reserves the right to photograph works for its promotional purposes.

#### DELIVERY AND COLLECTION

Kapunda Community Gallery Inc. has a standard changeover routine which applies to every exhibition. Please check the dates for the start and final day of the exhibition being entered and follow this procedure: Closing dates for entries and delivery of work will be in the Newsletter and on the Invitation to Exhibit flyer. The final day for delivery of work is on a Tuesday, hanging is on Wednesday and Thursday and the official opening of the exhibition is on a Sunday. The final day of each exhibition is on a Sunday, and works are taken down and collected on Monday.

Delivery and collection of works is between 10am and 4pm.
